Contest Instructions for Teachers

Dear Educator:

Now that your students have completed the UGI Energy Innovation presentation, they have new energy and water efficiency knowledge that can make a difference! Put this knowledge to use in the *Innovation Challenge*.

This contest challenges your students to communicate innovative ideas about increasing energy and/or water efficiency. The challenge is simple:

- 1. Discuss the home energy audit process in class. Determine areas where energy and/or water efficiency could be improved.
- 2. Teams, of up to four students, can use their creative energy to explore new and innovative ways to make a difference in energy and/or water efficiency.
- 3. Your students will apply their creative talents to communicate an idea to others through:
 - artwork
- literature
- video

- a science project
- photography
- a service project

- an essay
- music

- 4. Have your students submit their projects and entry form electronically at *thinkenergy.org/ugi-innovation* on or before **November 20, 2023**. Please email the signed permission forms to **ugienergyinnovation@nef1.org**.

Entries will be judged equally in the following categories:

- Theme: Does the entry communicate a way to be more energy and/or water efficient?
- **Originality and Creativity**: Does the entry represent original and creative work?
- **Impact**: Will the entry motivate others to be more energy and/or water efficient?

Students

Teachers

Grand prize winning team teacher will receive a \$500 mini-grant.

The DEADLINE for entry submission is on or before **November 20, 2023**.

- If your project was completed at school, you will need to give permission to the National Energy Foundation (NEF) to view it or send it from a personal email.
- Be prepared to answer the following questions on the digital entry form:
 - What message do you hope to convey?
 - What is the impact of your project in your life and in the lives of others?

- 3. Email this completed form, with both student and parent/guardian signatures, to **ugienergyinnovation@nef1.org** with your name and school name in the subject heading. This form will be matched to your digital entry form to verify eligibility.
